It is of utmost importance that all persons facilitate the safe movement of powered heavy equipment and eliminate or reduce, as far as reasonably practicable all hazardous interactions with heavy equipment.

TOOLBOX SAFETY TALK – HEAVY EQUIPMENT SAFETY



- Operators must sound horns when approaching blind corners, exiting and entering site buildings, approaching pedestrians from the rear and entering work areas where pedestrians are present and not aware of their approach.
- All heavy equipment (other than cars and trucks) must be fitted with a warning device indicating
 that the vehicle is operating (flashing light) and a warning device for reversing (such as a reverse
 beeper).
- Safety observers / spotters must be in place whenever trucks and trailers are being unloaded / loaded.



No person other than the operator is permitted to ride on heavy equipment unless the person is provided with a level of protection that is equivalent to that provided to the operator.
